Description: I just tried to upgrade my Redmine installation to ChiliProject, everything went all right except I cannot use anymore the wikis. I had exactly the same bug with Redmine 1.1.1. I cloned the Git repo in its own folder, so nothing could make a problem AFAIK from files not updated or so. What is happening: I can see the wiki pages, but the URLs for editing, renaming, etc. are just wrong. This is what they look like: /wiki/rename?page=Wiki. The result is just that I get 404 errors when trying to do anything with the wiki... When I go manually to URLs as they should be (i.e. /wiki/Wiki/edit, for example), I get no error. Working on Ruby 1.8.7, RoR 2.3.5, MySQL 5.0.84.

As it is working for the chiliproject.org site itself and for various other people, I merely suspect an issue that is specific to your installation. The most common cause of your issue is that you might have plugins installed that are not compatible with ChiliProject (or Redmine 1.1).

Please disable all plugins and check if the issue persists. Provide at least the output of @script/about@ and your gem list if it still doesn't work.
